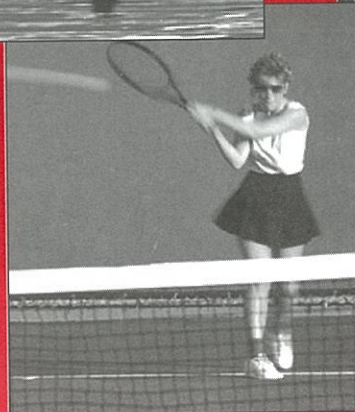
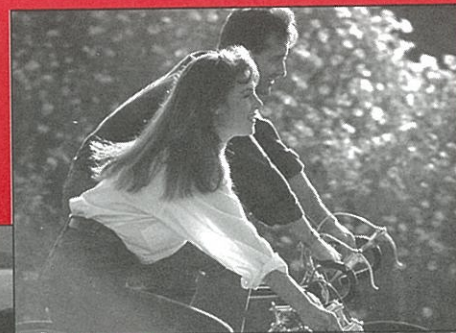

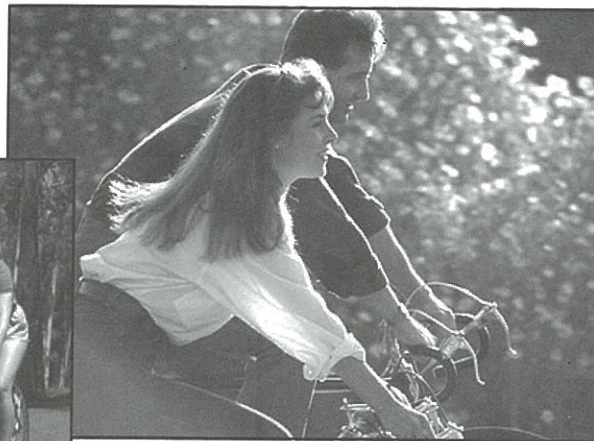

The Acadia Advanced Recreation Certificate

Primarily for those with an undergraduate degree in recreation and related professional experience, the Advanced Recreation Certificate provides an opportunity to update technical and human relations skills and to become conversant with concepts and social issues that arise in the field. The certificate is tangible evidence of a planned program of professional development and may be used to support career progress.

Requirements

- Ten continuing education units of approved instruction. One unit equals ten hours of seminar instruction.
- Applied Research Seminar and Study. The seminar is equal to 1.5 units and carrying out and presenting results of the study is equal to one unit. The field-based, problem-oriented study relates to your area of interest.



You can also receive credit for training seminars held at other locations. For example, the RANS Pre-conference seminar. Prior approval is required. For information on approved seminars contact RRCNS.

Mentorship and your program

Your program is designed in consultation with an assigned mentor, or counsellor, who is experienced in the recreation field. You design a program which reflects your own interests and trends in the field. Your mentor meets with you regularly, assists you with needs identification, helps you identify suitable professional development opportunities, and approves your personal development plan. Programs usually take three years to complete.

Admission and costs

You must complete the attached application form and submit it at least four weeks prior to starting your program. The application fee of \$100 must accompany the form.

Each training seminar has its own fees. Every effort is made to keep these costs low.
